RE: Formal Complaint 29 August 2014

Further to our letter dated 4 December, TTNZ Board has now discussed in detail your request for our Board to rule on costs.

It has been determined that regardless of any previous communication that TTNZ Board now advise the following:

1. TTNZ Board has been drawn into a dispute between NHTTA and yourself, a feud that has been on-going now for two years.
2. TTNZ Board was required to rule on your appeal as stated in NHTTA constitution (at that time), due to your dissatisfaction of a decision made by NHTTA.
3. Point 2 has been attended to and TTNZ Board believe we are now relieved of our constitutional responsibilities.
4. With regard to costs TTNZ Board directs you to mediate, and failing that, seek remedies **outside TTNZ Board**.

In terms of our previous advices TTNZ is charged with fostering table tennis in New Zealand, and with a number of issues over the past twelve months behind us, our desire, passion and energy must be refocused with that main goal in mind.
